#### Guidance

#### Using Catch - Up funding:

Mainstream schools will receive £80 for each pupil from reception to Year 11 inclusive.

Schools should use this funding for specific activities to support their pupils to catch up for lost teaching during the Covid pandemic, in line with curriculum expectations.

While schools can use their funding in a way that suits their cohort and circumstances, they are expected to use the funding for specific activities which will help pupils catch up on missed education.

To support schools to make the best use of this funding, the Education Endowment Fund (EEF) has published a guide to support schools and highlight effective practice:

#### **Accountability: School leaders and governors**

School leaders must be able to show they are using the funding to resume teaching a normal curriculum as soon as possible following a full or partial school closure.

Governors should scrutinise the school's approach to catch-up from September 2020, including their plans for and use of catch-up funding. This should Include consideration of whether the school is spending their funding in line with their catch-up priorities, and ensuring transparency for parents.

### **Strategy Statement**

At Nutley CE School, we will look at a number of barriers to learning when we identify which children to target with catch-up interventions. These barriers will include:

Poor attendance

Poor or inconsistent engagement with remote learning during full or partial school closures Attainment that is below expected levels, especially in reading
